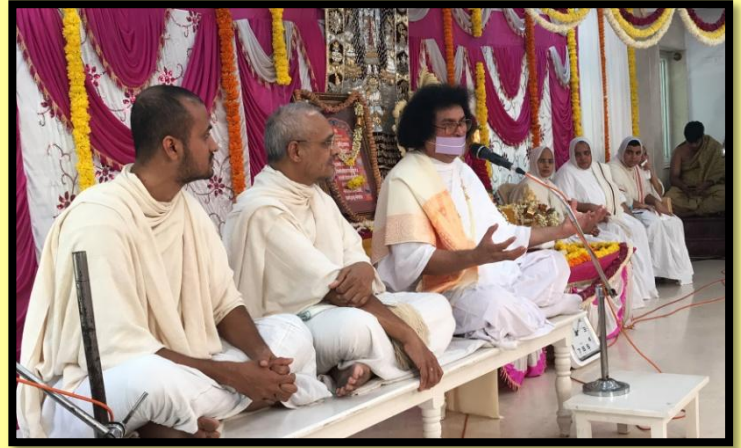




# Acharya Lokesh Gives Peace Message across the Country
