Born on 17th April 1961 and graduated in Gurukul tradition, Acharya Lokesh Muni is a spiritual leader, writer, orator and social activist.

He is the Founder President of Ahimsa Vishwa Bharti, a Delhi based voluntary organisation, which aims at promoting non-violence, peace, communal harmony, working against female foeticide & drug addiction and providing help natural calamities. Acharyaji worked to de-escalate Hindi Muslim strife after the Jama Masjid explosion in 2006 and tension between Dera Sacha Sauda and Sikh Community in 2007. He participated in 1500 km walk from Haryana to Gujarat to promote communal harmony. He studied Jainism, Buddhism and Vedic Philosophy and has 13 books to his creditincluding poetry books on subjects like female foeticide, terrorism, peace and brotherhood. A few among those published are Terrorism: A Global Challenge (2009), Neev Ko Naman (2005), Aastha ke Darpan (2005), Nirdwand ka Sansar (2003), Muly Mati Ka (2002), Jin Khoja Tin Payiaan (1993).

Indian Board of Alternative Medicines awarded him the Honorary Doctorate for his academic pursuits. He has also been honored with Naitik Samman by Gulzarilal Nanda Foundation and Bhaskar Puruskar by Bharat Nirman Sansthan for his contribution in restoring human values for peace and brotherhood.

Aged 49, **Acharya Lokesh Muni** is a writer, orator and social worker. He is the chief functionary of Ahimsa Vishwa Bharati, a Delhi based voluntary organisation which aims at promoting non-violence, peace, communal harmony, working against female foeticide & drug addiction, providing help during natural calamities, etc. Acharya Lokesh Muni worked to de-escalate Hindu Muslim strife after the Jama Masjid explosion in 2006-07 and tension between Dera Sacha Sauda and the Sikh community in 2007. He participated in a 1500 km walk from Haryana to Gujarat to promote communal harmony. Shri Muni studied Jainism, Buddhism and Vedic philosophy and has 12 books to his credit on subjects like female

foeticide, terrorism, principles of peace and brotherhood. For his academic pursuits, the Indian Board of Alternative Medicines awarded him the Doctor of Philosophy. He has also been honoured with the Naitik Samman Gulzarilal by the Nanda Foundation and Bhaskar Puraskar by Bharat Nirman Sangathan for his contribution in restoring human values of peace and brotherhood.

The National Communal Harmony Awards were instituted in 1996 by National Foundation Communal Harmony (NFCH), an autonomous organisation set up by the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, for promoting communal harmony and national integration. The award has been instituted with view demonstrating due appreciation and recognition of the efforts individuals and organisations for promotion of communal harmony and national integration in sustained manner over sufficiently long period of time.
