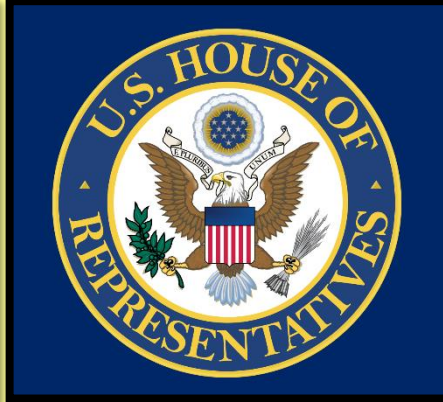


Acharya Lokeshji honored in House of Representatives, USA

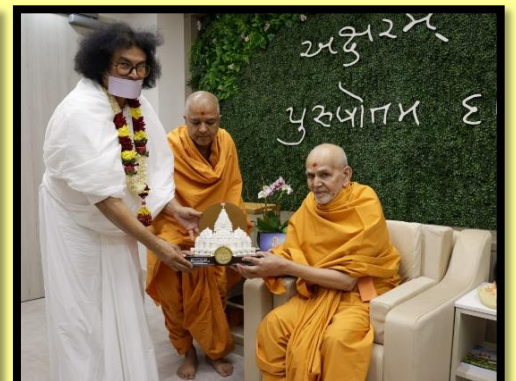
